


Welcome

Welcome to St. Ignatius Catholic School. We are a Pre-K-8th grade school modeled in the Ignatian tradition of education with a focus on academic excellence, faith formation, social justice and service, and strength of community. The faculty and staff at St. Ignatius strive to help each child seek the MAGIS, "the more"— by recognizing the unique gifts and talents of each individual and helping strengthen those God-given abilities so that they can become agents of goodness and change in the world. We are committed to developing the whole child—heart, mind, body, and soul.



At A Glance:

- 482 Pre-K- 8th grade students and 58 committed professionals on staff.
- 2 classes at each grade level with small class sizes ranging from 22-26 for K-8.
- Innovative academic model that combines station rotation, blended learning, skills based grouping across graade level, and individualized learning plans to meet the needs of each student.
- Departmentalized middle school with lockers, student selected electives (including art, Spanish, computer science, student leadership course, makerspace, lifetime fitness, choir/orchestra).
- STEAM (Science Technology Engineering Art Math) interwoven into the science curriculum, enhanced by Makerspace and science lab.Music (K-8), fine arts, (K-8), choir, and liturgy opportunities.
- Outdoor learning space, community garden, and opportunities for outdoor learning and exploration.
- Full/part time pre-school options for 3-4 year old students.

- State of the art building with flex learning spaces to facilitate skills-based grouping and collaboration, flooded in natural light and modern technology infrastructure.
- K-8 service and social justice curriculum, including individual, class and school wide service projects and Social Justice Fair.
- School wide, up-to-date technology, including smart TVs in each classroom, iPads and ChromeBooks for K-6th grade and 1:1 ChromeBook device for 7th-8th grade.
- Participation in Treasure Valley Catholic Schools sports programs and activities, including football, track, cross country, basketball, volleyball, band.
- Academic differentiation and individualization with additional support services as we are reasonably able to offer.
- Before and after school care available.
- Focus on teaching healthy habits including run-walk club, wellness program, healthy hot lunch offered daily.



ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

In the Ignatian tradition, quality teaching, critical thinking, and rigorous academic standards are the cornerstone to growing each child to their highest potential. We offer a rich and vibrant PreK-8 Catholic education that blends traditional academic course work with a commitment to enrichment curriculum in the arts, music, and foreign language. We respect the individuality of each child, and we are committed to addressing the academic challenges and strengths of each student. Our small class sizes provide increased individual attention, studentteacher interaction and individualized learning opportunities.
